**Lent Madness** began in 2010 as the brainchild of the Rev. Tim Schenck from St. John the Evangelist in Hingham, Massachusetts. In 2012 he partnered with *Forward Movement* and Executive Director Scott Gunn to create The Lent Madness website and broaden the number of people involved in the process, with Tim and Scott serving as the self-appointed Supreme Executive Committee. In seeking a fun, engaging way for people to learn about the men and women comprising the Church's Calendar of Saints, Tim (and Scott) came up with this unique Lenten devotion. Combining a love of sports with a passion for the lives of the saints, Lent Madness was born. The format is straightforward: 32 saints are placed into a tournament-like single elimination bracket. Each pairing remains open for a set period of time and people vote for their favorite saint. 16 saints make it to the Round of the Saintly Sixteen; eight advance to the Round of the Elate Eight; four make it to the Faithful Four; two to the Championship; and the winner is awarded the coveted Golden Halo.
